

The meeting was called to order on **March 7, 2006** at 8:00p.m. Roll call was taken and present were Curtis Moen, David Hermanson, Kelly Hermanson, Sean Shilling and Yvonne Ogren. Others present were Dick & Marilyn Jaeger, Nana Showalter, Bob Bergman, Dan Truttmann, Dan Reeson, Steve Hermanson and Ron Fuhr. The minutes of the previous meeting were read. Curtis asked for one correction. On the historic section of the comprehensive plan it should read 1000BC instead of 1000AC. Then Curtis made a motion to accept the minutes as read with the correction and Sean seconded it.

Under old business we received copies of the newly revised driveway permit ordinance from Dan Truttmann. We decided to review it and go over it at our next meeting. Next on the agenda Curtis brought up more information on our historic sites. It was discussed that people should be made aware of these various sites so that they could stay protected. Maybe a letter sent out to people who live in these various areas to make them aware of these sites. Some information was given for some of the oldest buildings. The blacksmith shop dates back to 1856, Royalty School House between 1856-58 and also the old cheese factory. Some ideas were to compile a map to show these various locations for recognition or have a committee set up to do this. It was decided to have Marilyn Jaeger put in the paper that if anyone knew of any other historical sites to let us know and also put this information on the website and contact Kelly Hermanson. I also put this information in the New Glarus paper. Next on the agenda was discussion on light pollution. Bob Bergman told us he was told to just spray black paint on top of his light and this would direct the light down to the ground. David gave us the following on lighting. Use 50 watt, 100 maximum and white or pale yellow in color. Amber Ridge and others don't allow any dusk to dawn lights. Sean suggested putting a handout together. We could put it on the website and also include it with the driveway permit forms and code of living. He will put this together and bring it to the next meeting. New business: There was some discussion on the Green County's moratorium. Nothing will be resolved until June or July.

Next on the agenda was the land division presented by Ron Fuhr/Wilde Realty for the John Kernen property. The property is located on Farmers Grove Road and County J. He is selling 35 acres of 40 with the buildings. He is putting one unit on this division and it will be located near the road, making it a short driveway. Ron Fuhr will get an updated copy of this application to the plan commission board. Sean made a motion to recommend this land division to the town board for approval and Curtis seconded it. There also was some discussion on articles concerning the plan commission. Next months meeting will start later because of Election Day. Sean made a motion to adjourn the meeting and Curtis seconded it. The meeting was adjourned at 9:15p.m.
